Commander George A. Noggle, Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. G. Alfred Noggle of Carlisle, Pennsylvania, graduated from Navy Officers Candidate School in October 1956. His initial tour was aboard USS TULARE (LKA 112) as Communications Officer.
