### 2. INVOLUNTARY EXTENSION OF OVERSEAS TOURS:

Following is extracted from letter, subject: Involuntary Extensions of Overseas Tours, dated 3 November 1960, Headquarters, Department of the Army:

"The critical shortage of travel funds resulting from a Congressional reduction in the MPA travel budget and a limitation on monies that may be spent for travel dictates that additional measures be taken to reduce PCS travel costs in FY 1961. In order to effect required savings with the least possible inconvenience to military personnel, decision has been made to extend oversea tours of all personnel in long tour areas who are due to return to the CONUS in June 1961 into July 1961. To accomplish this action simply by eliminating travel in June and adding June returnees to the normal July loads would impose insurmountable transportation problems. Therefore, additional extensions are necessary. These will be spread over the 3 month period, 1 April 1961 to 30 November 1961, by extending portions of each month's scheduled returnees. Normally personnel will be returned in the same relative order as they arrived in the oversea command."

Personnel of this command will be scheduled for rotation as follows:
